Keyboard virtuoso Richard Egarr offers inspired readings from among Bach's most familiar solo works (*Italian Concerto*, *Chromatic Fantasia & Fugue*) and rarely heard transcriptions of Vivaldi, plus his own completion of the unfinished Fugue in C minor, BWV 906.
