



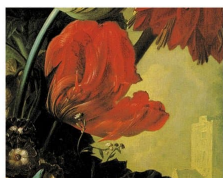

Figuring in Bach's necrology in the midst of a "crowd of instrumental works of diverse kinds, for all sorts of instruments", these sonatas written for an instrumental trio were long neglected, not to say completely ignored. Their rediscovery by modern performers has thrown light on a whole different area of the great Cantor's work.
