# The Seven Last Words of Jesus Christ on the Cross SWV 478

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Compared with a genuine Baroque theatrical style, the *Seven Words from the Cross* is a paradox. This *Historia* of the Passion seems to be at the very opposite pole of the great Baroque Passions like the oratorios of the Catholic Counter-Reformation. On the contrary, everything contributes to interiorise the *Seven Last Words of Christ* in a serene meditation which the music raises to the level of contemplation: "The Seven Words of Jesus on the Cross, keep them close in your heart", the five voices sing in the exordium. The vision, so individual, can only be interior. (*Jean-Pierre Ouvrard*).

This title was released for the first time in 1987.
